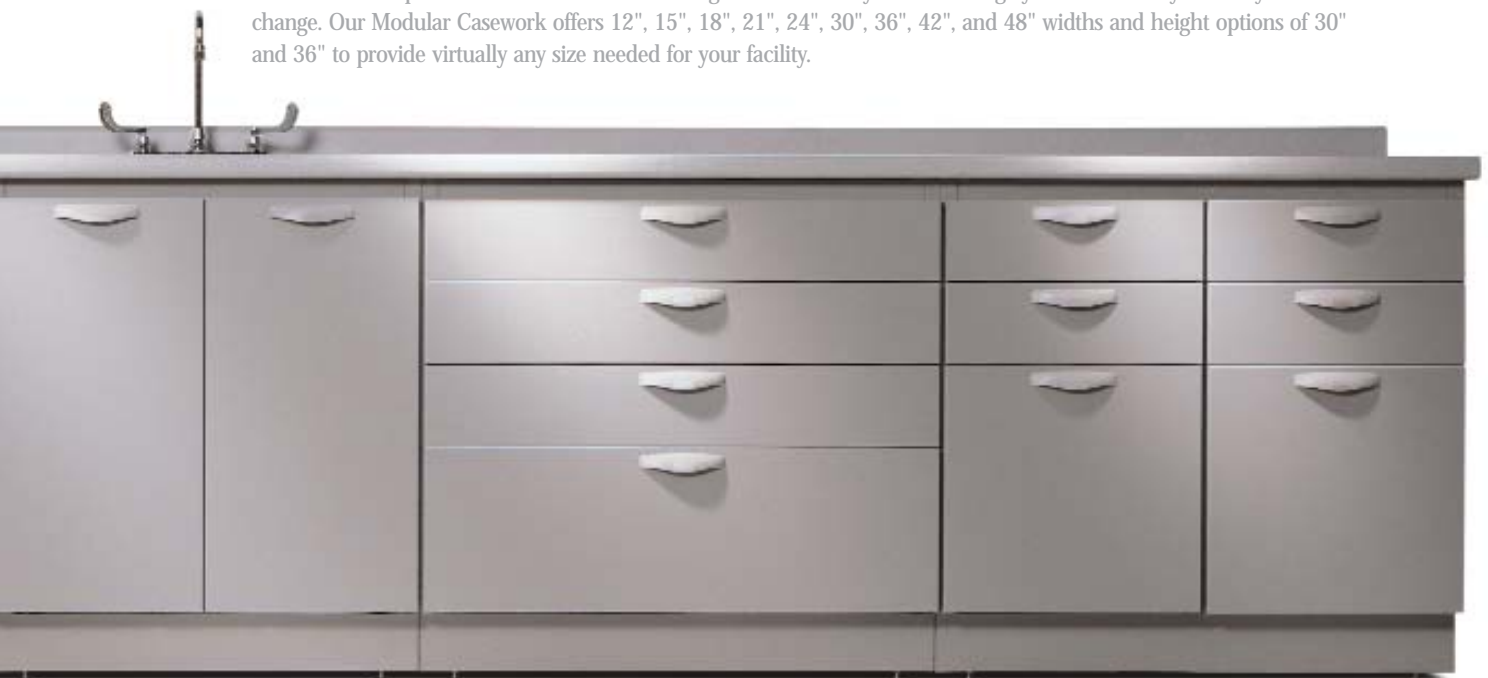

Our Hettich® MultiTech Drawer System, rated at 100 lbs., is a strong, long-lasting system that stresses affordability.



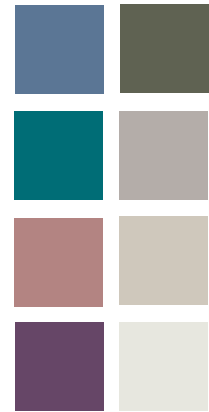
Hinges
